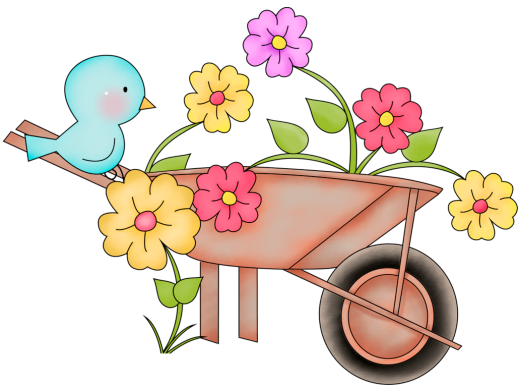


ACE SECOND GRADE
